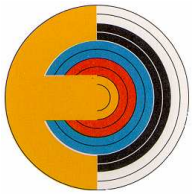

3rd leg 2- 7 June Antalya (TUR) - Technical Delegate: Eva Thesen (NOR)

The 2009 competitions will be run following the FITA Round format and should host both Recurve and Compound divisions.
