1) Opening of the Congress by WAE Secretary General Mrs Alessandra Colasante

The 19th Congress was opened by a welcoming message by World Archery Europe Secretary General Alessandra Colasante:

Let me welcome all of you here in Essen today at the 19th General Assembly of WAE. Before starting the roll call, I wish to thank the German Shooting and Archery Federation for the great assistance in the Congress preparation and in the logistic management of all of us attending this Congress at the eve of the 2024 European Championships.

There aren't any later arrivals, so the registration is completed and we can go on with the roll call by using the tablets to confirm your attendance.

2) Report of Registration

The Secretary General, Alessandra Colasante, after the roll call, announces that 32 Member Associations are in attendance and in good standing, so the quorum is achieved.

4) Confirmation of the minutes of 2022 Congress

There were not any questions nor comments arising from the minutes of the previous Congress, so the minutes were considered as approved unanimously

5) Welcoming by WAE President Mr Mario Scarzella

The President opened the session and welcomed the delegates.

6) Welcoming by WA President Prof. Dr. Ugur Erdener

WA President, Prof. Dr. Ugrur Erdener, welcomes all the delegates attending the Congress and expresses his happiness to join the continental association general assembly.

7) Welcoming by Minister/State Secretary Mrs Andrea Milz

Mrs Andrea Milz expresses her satisfaction in hosting such a valuable international event in Essen and welcomes all the participants.

8) Welcome Speech by WA Secretary General Mr Tom Dielen

WA Secretary General, Mr Tom Dielen, shows some slides about a general update on WA staff at WA office and WA Excellence Centre, about Governance in Sports, he gives an overview on Paris 2024 general matters and current situation on the Qualification process. About the events, he deals with World Ranking events increased in quality and broadcasting, on the strict deadlines and the system of the international block calendar.

9) Welcome Speech by DSB President Mr Hans-Heinrich von Schönfels

The President of German Shooting Sport & Archery Federation warmly welcomes the delegates for the second Congress in a row hosted in Germany. He expresses his satisfaction about his Federation work and wish the most successful results at the upcoming Championships.

10) Report by WAE President:

The President Mario Scarzella read the following report to the delegates in attendance:

Dear Friends,

firstly, I wish to welcome warmly all of you to our 19th Congress.

I wish all you delegates a good work today for the development of Archery in the following years. We now go on with the Congress giving the floor to my friend and WA President Ugur Erdener.

Firstly, I wish to stress on my great pleasure to have here with us the World Archery President Ugur Erdener and the World Archery Secretary General Tom Dielen, who I thank sincerely for their attendance as a confirmation of the positive and fruitful cooperation between WAE and WA. In

a special way, I wish to thank sincerely my friend Ugur Erdener because the visibility of our sport has never been so high and he makes the future of Archery look very brilliant.

I am writing this report just after a period of illness, when my health conditions did prevent me from travelling, consequently I was forced to be far away from the Field of Plays of our events and this happened for the very first time in my life. I wish to take the opportunity to thank all of you who demonstrated me closeness and affection, you can't imagine how glad I am to be here in front of you today. As you can see, I fully recovered now and I am back travelling around Europe as I used to do.

Today, as it happened two years ago for the 2022 Congress, we are once more guests of the German Shooting and Archery Federation, of the President Mr Hans-Heinrich von Schönfels and the Secretary General Mr Joerg Brokamp, who I wish to thank both for the warm hospitality reserved to all of us in this fascinating setting of a Mine.

As usually, we are having our General Assembly at the eve of the European Championships, whose edition is slightly different on this time. In fact, we have the Continental Qualification Tournament (CQT) as a standalone event held prior to our continental championships. The most of us are looking forward to securing an individual quota place to the next Olympic Games in Paris.

Considering the general background, we are living in, I must say that we are still facing the consequences of the pandemic. Its financial implications are still very real and affect many of our member associations where also competitions at national level suffer from those financial consequences.

I am pleased to say that Archery in Europe is reporting a more and more constant growth at the highest levels. In all the international events a huge participation of the European teams is always registered with excellent results. Let me congratulate also to all those WAE Member Associations whose athletes have already achieved quota places to Paris Olympic and Paralympic Games.

There is another aspect which is worth mentioning briefly: the Para Archery Cup Circuit we have noticed a growing participation year by year. The first stage of 2024 Para Cup Circuit is combined with the European Para Championships as usually held on the even years. The difference we are dealing with this year, is that for the first time the European Para Championships, to be held in Rome at the end of this month, will not have the status of world ranking event because the date is overlapping with a World Archery event. We are realizing that the international calendar is getting a more and more busy schedule of events quite difficult to match and bearing down on the costs for the National Associations.

Let me mention another European competition I'm particularly attached to because it gives us a lot of satisfaction in term of achievements, results and

participation: the Youth Cup Circuit. I must highlight that its organization is achieving resounding success with a well-established attendance, year by year, we are registering a higher number of participants, so the Youth Cup is now considered one of the most valid international tests for our young athletes.

Talking about media and communication, we are constantly improving our website, social media and way of linking our sport and our Federations. Later on, we will highlight the numbers of our growing visibility through the report of WAE Web Media Responsible.

A very good objective of this year, which is worth mentioning briefly, is the definition of the new WAE Strategy for the next four years. It has represented a great example of the good cooperation we have inside the European Archery family and a fruitful opportunity to exchange ideas. Later on, I hand over to Steve Tully the DTAC Chairperson, who will present the key points of the next 4 years strategy so that you might vote for its approval and adoption. I take the opportunity to thank Steve for this ambitious and well-built strategy, which is the result of his work.

In the last part of my report, I wish to thank the members of WAE Executive Board and WAE Committees and Liaisons, whose worthy work and positive cooperation contribute to our growth and to the several goals we aimed. I wish to take the occasion to congratulate all our Technical Delegates for the positive and constructive work they do for the benefit and development of European Archery events. Also the Continental Judges, with their commitment they contribute to the best technical and competitive outcome of our tournaments.

I really must thank our new sponsor ERREA. The WAE Judges are wearing the new uniform since the beginning of the year and we all are very satisfied with the high quality of the material.

Finally, let me address a special thanks to Mr Christian La Forest for his competence and proficiency combined with his excellent cooperation and great disposal, and to Mrs Alessandra Colasante for being my right-hand person and for her very efficient work in WAE Secretariat.

Last but not least, a huge thanks to all of you, who work constantly for Archery development in your belonging countries.

16) World Archery Europe Strategy – presented by DTAC Chair Mr Steve Tully

The DTAC Chairperson Mr Steve Tully presents the WAE strategic development plan for the period 2024-2028. The new strategy is approved by the Congress delegates.

17) **Voting on Motions**

The motions to the Constitution require a two-third majority.

Before the voting started, the Secretary General felt the floor to Matteo Pisani for an overview of the election process and some voting tests.

The Congress delegates voted on the 3 Motions and 2 Amendments.

Motion n. 1 about adding the Sustainability Liaison (submitted by WAE Executive Board)

This motion was put forward by WAE Executive Board and it's aimed to add the Sustainability Liaison, who would work to progress WAE environmental, social and economic sustainability.

Voting on Motion 1 (32 votes available – 22 votes majority requested - 31 Yes). Passed

Amendment to Motion n. 2 about Vacancy in a Committee (Submitted by Member Association: Archery GB)

This amendment was put forward by Archery GB to focus on gender balance or skills in the case of two individuals having the same number of votes at the previous Congress.

Voting on Amendment to motion 2 (32 voting delegates - 20 votes majority requested - 25 Yes). Passed

Motion n. 2 about Vacancy in a Committee (submitted by WAE Executive Board)

This motion was put forward by WAE Executive Board to resolve the procedure that could arise in the future with the necessity to reintegrate a new member of the Committees, not only in case of resignation but also in case of vacancy. Such a motion is aimed to enable the Committees to continue to be effective if a member can no longer participate

Voting on Motion 2 (32 voting delegates – 21 majority requested - 30 Yes). Passed

Amendment to Motion n. 3 about Vacancy in the Executive Board (Submitted by Member Association: Archery GB)

This amendment was put forward by Archery GB to clarify that substitutes only serve until the next Congress. it's aimed to focus on gender balance or skills-based replacement in the case of two individuals having the same number of votes at the previous Congress.

Voting on Amendment to motion 3 (32 voting delegates - 20 votes majority requested - 26 Yes). Passed

Motion n. 3 about Vacancy in the Executive Board (submitted by WAE Executive Board)

This motion was put forward by WAE Executive Board to resolve the procedure that could arise in the future with the necessity to reintegrate a new member of the Executive Board, not only in case of resignation but also in case of vacancy, in order to be consistent with the electoral procedures after each Congress.
