CONGRESS 2006: MARIO SCARZELLA ELECTED NEW EMAU PRESIDENT

Jaen (Spain), 13 March 2006 – Mario Scarzella has been elected the new President of the EMAU during the Congress held in Jaen.

He was elected by a vote of 35-5 over Klaus Lindau (GER), the other candidate, who was EMAU acting President for 9 months before the Congress.

Mario Scarzella succeeds Dr. Ugur Erdener who retired from the EMAU presidency after his election as FITA President.

Mr Scarzella is the President of the Italian Archery Federation and he is also a FITA Council Member.
