Re: Last Council Meeting decisions

Dear Mr President,

I would like to inform you about some decisions taken by the EMAU Council, during the last meeting held on 6 November in Rome.

Considering the last decisions approved by the FITA Congress, the EMAU Council stated that all the European competitions will be managed with the new rules, as per 1st April 2010. The European Outdoor Championships (Rovereto, ITA) and the Grand Prix legs (Greece, Armenia and Russia), will follow the new rules: 70m Round followed by the Olympic Round (including sets system for Individuals and Mixed Team Round with the title for both Recurve and Compound Division). Regular scoring for the teams.

European Championships

The following Championships were allocated:

European Outdoor Championships 2012 to the Archery Association of The Netherlands. The Championships will be held in Amsterdam.

European Indoor Championships 2011 to the Spanish Archery Federation. The Championships will be held in Salou (Tarragona).

European Clubteams Cup

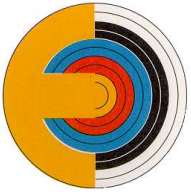
The European Clubteams Cup for 2010 will be held in Izmir (TUR) on 1-3 October.
