COUNCIL MINUTES

Jaen, Spain, 12 March 2006

The Council meeting was held in Jaen, Spain, on 12 March 2006 the day before the Congress. All members were attending.

The Agenda was the following:

The Acting President, Klaus Lindau, informed the members that Mr. Dimitrios Razis, President of the Greek Federation, was invited to come to the meeting.

1) Congress preparation

The Congress examined the Agenda and the documents of the Congress. The Acting President Klaus Lindau distributed the procedure for the Continental Quota Places for the Olympic Games 2008 at the European Target Championship 2008 in Vittel (France) which is the same system used in Bruxelles. He also affirmed that it is necessary to improve our sport if Archery wants to keep staying in the Olympic program.

2) Last Council Meeting minutes approval The minutes were approved.

3) Budget 2006

The budget 2006 was examined by the Members after that the changes requested during the last Council meeting were made.

At 11 o'clock Mr. Dimitrios Razis was invited to attend the Council meeting. He informed the Council members regarding the organization of the European Target Championship in Athens. The hotels and the field for the competition are not near to each other, and the Council suggested to find another field because of the traffic jam in Athens.

The Council asked him to send all information to the Member Associations not later than April 21th, 2006. If the Greek Federation will not respect such a date, the Council will ask to another Country to organize the European Target Championship 2006.

4) EMAU Liaisons

The Council decided to delete the positions of all the Liaisons so to let the new Council appoint the new ones.

5) EMAU Calendar

It is necessary during the Congress to invite the MAs to bid for the organization of the Outdoor Junior Target Championships in 2007, the European Outdoor Championship in 2008 and all the European Championships from 2009.

6) Other permissible business

The Council discussed on some presents to give to the Authorities on behalf of EMAU. It was decided to ask an offer for 50 big crest with the EMAU logo.

It was also decided to order the ribbons for the medals. The ribbons must be without hooks.
