

#### WA-Europe DTAC Report

For WAE Congress, on 26 August 2018 - Legnica/POL

#### • 2018 WAE Coaches Trainer Course – Level 1, in Austria

Since 2011 it is successfully implemented the WAE project for Coaching Course Conductors and Coaches Trainer Course, with participants nominated by European Federations, but also open to participants from WA Member Associations who fulfilled the Experts criteria.

Following the previous years' organizations, the years 2018 and 2019 organization of a Coaches Trainer Course (Level 1 & Level 2 accordingly) was allocated to the Austrian Archery Federation.

In a common project with World Archery, WAE, OS, the NOC of Austria and the Austrian Archery Federation, in cooperation with WA Development and Education Director, Mr. Pascal Colmaire, it was organized the 2018 WAE Coaches Trainer Course-Level 1 in Salzburg, on 18-28 June 2018.

The Level 2 Coach Trainer course is scheduled to be organized by the Austrian Archery Federation, for 7 days in 2019 (tbc), for the WA certified Level 1 Coach Trainers, with a good experience.

The 2018 WAE CTC, was an 11 days Level 1 Course, jointly running with World Archery, educating totally 8 participants on how to train Level 1 archery coaches. Each MA nominated one participant, on the base first come first served.

It is concluded that the small number of participants is because of the late announcement of the course. A minimum of two-month notice would have been much better than the 5 weeks we had.

The 2018 course Experts was: Mr. Pascal Colmaire, WA Development & Education Director and Mr. Martin Ptacnik, Austrian archery Coaches Trainer Level 2.

The Experts educated and trained the 8 participants in Level 1 coaching, using electronic documents, power point and indoor & outdoor practice, with daily morning and afternoon sessions along with meals and coffee breaks.

In 2018 course, there was a positive reaction from the participants, who fully attended the course, with satisfaction for developing their knowledge and skills in the very experienced hands of the lecturer, Pascal Colmaire.

All candidates had the appropriate level and profile to attend the course and for the Level 1 Coach Trainer in archery.

The Austrian Archery Federation and Olympic Committee were very supportive and helpful; hence they are recommended to organize further courses. The organizers offered an excellent hospitality and good conditions in accommodation for the participants and experts.

The preparation and organization of the course was good, although the space could have been bigger and the range for the practice less noisy.

Officials from World Archery Europe DTAC were present at the opening. From the Austrian Federation at the closing and during the course.

At the end of the course the participants received their WAE Certificates as "Level 1 Archery Coaches' Trainer Candidate".

By the end of 2018 they should conduct a successful level 1 archery coaching course, before they receive their final Certificate as: **"WAE Level 1 Archery Coaches Trainer"**. This nomination and certification will be valid until the end of 2022 inclusive and will be reevaluated and certified every 4 years.

All the costs related to the 2018 WAE Coaches Trainer Course-Level 1 were funded by the Olympic Solidarity, with the contribution of 100 € per participant and was included: onsite transportation, full board accommodation, training facilities and course equipments & tools. Travel cost was at the participant's charge.

### • National Coaching Course in Latvia

Latvian Federation will organize an 8-day Level 1 National Coaching Course in Latvian language, for 20 Latvian participants, on 25 September – 2 October 2018, via the Olympic Solidarity programme and funding. Expert of this course will be Mr. Pascal Colmaire, with translation in language. Latvian Federation has the approval of their NOC for this project.

## DTAC contribution to the Federations for their participation to the 2018 WAE Coaches Trainer Course in Austria

WAE usually assists financially a part of travel cost of the successfully participated European MAs, as DTAC contribution for their participants travel cost, attending to the 2018 WAE Coaches Trainer Course, held in Salzburg/Austria.

A total amount of 1.400 €, for DTAC contribution will be covered by DTAC Budget 2018.
