"The President Mario Scarzella read the following report to the delegates in attendance:

Later on, the welcoming speech from WA President Ugur Erdener, at this Congress, we have the pleasure to have in attendance with us the World Archery Secretary General, Tom Dielen, who I thank sincerely for his greetings. Moreover, I wish to thank both of them him for their work in order to raise our sport to the highest international levels.

Due to Covid-19, the main events in our calendars were cancelled or postponed, now we are facing for the next two years fully packed and thick calendars. From the Para Archery point of view, this year was also complicated by the cancellation of the European Para Archery Championships and brilliantly replaced by Nove Mesto Para Archery Cup Circuit Organizers, who will manage the challenge of continental and final quota tournaments in one event.

A very good objective of this year, which is worth mentioning briefly, is the creation of the first WAE Strategic Plan, that will be shown you in a while after my report. It is a great example of the good cooperation we have inside the European Archery family.

*I* wish to thank the members of WAE Executive Board and WAE Committees and Liaisons, who, with their worthy work and positive cooperation, contribute to our growth and to the several goals we aimed.

I wish to thank them also their appreciated availability and cooperation with World Archery Europe, and covering their task for one extra year. Prix.

I really must thank our sponsors Dream Bow Factory, Martin & Miglioranza and Ragim, which are going on supporting us even in this quite challenging financial period.

I take the opportunity to thank our Local Organizing Committees, who have successfully organized events also within difficult circumstances, nevertheless always guarantying the respect of the healthy measures. As far as our financial resources are concerned, we are glad to inform you that at the moment we manage to satisfy the ambitious objectives of our newly born Strategy, and we can definitely keep working for the widespread development of European Archery.

Talking about media and communication, we are constantly improving our services, and for this success I must thank Gabriele Giovine, our media responsible for his skilled work. After my Report conclusion, I hand over to Gabriele for his report on our last social media successes.

In the last part of my report, I wish to thank also the Technical Delegates and our Judges, who with their work, contribute to the best outcome of our tournaments, however this year they have had an even more complicated work due to PCR tests, travel restrictions and general uncertainty linked to the pandemic. Thank you for your great patience.

Let me address a very special thanks to Mr Christian Laforest for his excellent skilled cooperation and great disposal, and to WAE Secretary General for her very efficient work and vast availability.
