PRELIMINARY FINAL REGISTRATION

No entry forms will be available for registering for this event. The registration process is to be done using the World Archery Results and Entry Online System (WAREOS).

The number of athletes that may be entered by a Member Association is limited to three (3) in each category.

All World Archery Europe MAs are eligible to compete in the European Youth Championships 2020

Please respect the stated deadlines.

Member Associations should only use WAREOS to make any changes or amendments to entries and will be able to do so at any time. Any changes made in WAREOS an email will be automatically sent to the Organising Committee and Member Association with the updated information.

However, any changes that are made after the deadlines specified or if entries differ by more than four athletes from the preliminary entries, the following penalty fees will automatically be applied:

If final entries differ from the preliminary entries by more than four

Failure to have made preliminary entries before the deadline date but then

Any entries received less than three days before the team managers meeting will be refused if no preliminary entry and/or final entry are made prior.

As a final note, only Member Associations in good standing will be eligible to compete. This means that World Archery fee must have been paid prior to participation.



To confirm the reservation, a 75% deposit of the total amount is required to be bank transferred to the LOC before **15 May 2020**. Reservations after this date will be considered only according to availability, the room rate can change and we cannot guarantee rooms in the official hotel.

Final Hotel Reservations and remaining payment should be made before 29 June 2020.

Note: Please ensure that you complete all the necessary forms by the specified dates and make full payment for the accommodation at the time of booking. See detailed payment instructions below.

Entry fees:

Individual: €150 - Per Athlete
Officials: €60 - Per Offical

Teams: €75 - (no fee for mixed teams)

Transportation fees from/to the airports:

The LOC will collect the teams from Birmingham International airport. You have to pay the transportation fee that includes arrival and departure as follows:

Birmingham International Airport /BHX/ 45 miles

€85 per person

(transfers should take 50 minutes to 1 hour)

The last date for the payment of the transportation details must be with the LOC no later than 29 June. All fees must be paid not later than 28 July 2020.

From the airports to the hotel / return trip, the organiser will use buses, small buses, vans and cars, which will depend on number of persons scheduled for transportation.

Transportation from the airports will start Saturday 15 August and will end AM Monday 24 August. Transport requests outside of these dates can be arranged by special arrangement with the LOC.

PAYMENT CONDITIONS

- The Entry Fee should be paid in full before 28 July 2020.
- The 75% deposit of the total amount for hotel accommodation should be paid before 19 May 2020
- The full balance of payment for accommodation and total transportation should be paid before 28 July 2020

Cancellations & Changes:

All cancellations and changes must be made through WAREOS:

- Received before 19 May 2020, for full refund of the deposit payment
- Received before 29 June 2020, for 50% refund of the deposit payment
- Received after 29 June 2020, no refund
- Refunds, if any, will be processed after the end of the event
- Late arrivals or early departures than the originally scheduled, the room will be charged from the date of the original booking in WAREOS
- Name changes to team officials or athletes (same category and division) will be accepted up to **three** days before the event without any additional charge
- Should flight details change last minute, please contact the Organising Committee
- An email will automatically notify the Organising Committee and Member Association of any changes made in WAREOS.

Lunches at the venue:

Lunch will be served for all Athletes and Officials at Lilleshall in Ford Hall. This will start on Sunday 16 August and end on Saturday 22 August. There will be two sittings each day and Athletes / Officials must attend their designated time slot.

Drinking water will be available on the competition field free of charge. We will be using water fountains.

Any charges made in cafeteria at the archery venue or in the hotel are not included in the entry fee and must be paid on ordering.
