

Meals

#### Local transport

Visitors can take a direct bus from Nottingham to Sherwood Forest.

The <u>Nottsbus On Demand service</u> connects various communities, including Newark Castle, Northgate train stations, Newark Bus Station, Newark Showground, and Newark Hospital. It also serves Bingham Marketplace, Bottesford Train Station, East Bridgford's Blue Diamond Garden Centre, North and South Ollerton, Mansfield, and West Rushcliffe. Keep in mind that Nottsbus on Demand doesn't follow a fixed route or timetable.







