Text of the motion	Amend the 5th bullet point to read "No WAE member association may have accredited more than 9 Continental Judges (including WA IJ and IC) with a minimum of 3 female. <b>If an MA sends more candidates than spaces to a WAE Judge Seminar and they pass the exam it is the responsibility of the MA to choose which candidates fill the space(s). The candidate(s) who the MA do not select will need to repeat the entire process at a future seminar.</b> "
6. Reason	Previously it said "No WAE member association may have accredited more than 9 Continental Judges (including WA IJ and IC) with a minimum of 3 female"  The change means that if an MA sends more candidates then there is space for, for example they have 2 spaces and send 3 candidates, and they all pass then it is the MA's responsibility to choose which 2 candidates become Continental Judges. The candidate who is not chosen must complete the entire
